Minutes of a meeting of the Staffing & Policies Committee convened on Monday 28 June 2021 at 7.00 pm in the Margaret Oliver Hall at Bayston Hill Memorial Hall.

ELECTION OF CHAIR FOR THIS MEETING – Through omission "Election of Chairman" is not on tonight's agenda. **Clir Clode was proposed as Chairman for this meeting by AP, seconded MU** – **All in favour**

- SP1.21/22 **TO RECEIVE APOLOGIES AND REASONS FOR ABSENCE** None.
- SP2.22/22 **DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST –** None.
- SP3.21/22 MINUTES The draft minutes of the meeting held on 15 March 2021 were presented for approval as a true record, proposed MU, seconded AP to accept unanimously approved and signed by the Chair.
- SP4.21/22 **UPDATE ON RECRUITMENT OF BOTH CLERK/RFO & DEPUTY CLERK** SJ updated the committee members as follows:-
 - For the Clerk/RFO position no completed applications have been received. It was agreed to re-post the position from Mid-August for one month.
 - For the Deputy Clerk position 5 applications have been received. The interview panel of TC, CC & MU shortlisted 3 candidates based on the Person Specification. One candidate withdrew ahead of the interviews taking place. Both candidates attended the Bowling Pavilion on Tuesday last and on the points awarded just 4 points differentiated. It was proposed MU, seconded CC, to invite both candidates to make a 10 minute presentation on "What would your first 30 days in the role look like?" All in favour. Tuesday 13th July 2021 is set and a decision on who should be recommended for the Deputy Clerk position will be agreed and put to the following Full Council meeting.

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- SP5.21/22 LONGMEADOW PLAY AREA CARETAKER COVER The current post holder has indicated that she expects to submit notice to leave by 30th September 2021. SJ put to members whether it was necessary to look to recruit a replacement. Maybe a 3 month trial of no longer locking the Play Area overnight resulting in a saving of public money might be agreed? Members agreed to such a trail in principle but with reference to our insurers beforehand and then recommend to Full Council. All in favour.
- SP6.21/22 **DRAFT STAFF APPRAISAL POLICY FOR REVIEW** With two corrections Section 3 Step 3 agreed, **the policy was recommended to be adopted, proposed MU, seconded AP All in favour.**
