Tree Planting in the Sensory Garden (Request received from The Village Association)

“The Village Association has been left a small legacy by a resident in Bayston Hill and we thought that it would be a good idea to use some of the money to plant some trees in the gentleman’s memory in the Sensory Gardens. As discussed with Mark, ideally the trees should go in the flat area and not in the area which is being preserved for wildlife. There is a picnic table in the middle of the Sensory Gardens and I suggested that two groups of 3 trees be planted at the edge of this ground at a distance from the table but either side of it. I am happy to come up with some suggestions of which trees to use if and when the Council agree to this in principle.

I suggest that around October would be a good time to do the planting. This would give time to order specific trees and decide on a position for them. I appreciate that there are lots of trees in the area all around but I think that there is certainly room for more. Particularly in this, the Queen's Platinum Jubilee Year and the environment would obviously benefit as well.”
