- 1. Long Meadow
- a) Toilet Block, Front door currently secured by screws into door frame, so no key lock access. Rear door locked and used to store Jingleation apparatus. Could front door access be restored and toilet access be provided?
- b) Steel container in far-left corner, roof rusted and no longer providing dry storage.
- c) Early presence of some weeds in matting under basket swing
- d) Member of public invited to comment during visit and suggested a piece of apparatus that would provide children to use their imagination (Hanwood Park, Galleon?)
- 2. BMX Track and Skate Park
- a) Would a school holiday skill-teaching session be of interest to the community?
- b) BMX Track work surfacing expected to be completed Oct/Nov
- 3. Stanley Parker Playing fields
- a) Ideas for additional community participation in facilities
- i) Semi-permanent stage set-up at the Parrs Wood end for community events
- ii) Christmas fair stalls in conjunction with Jingleation
- b) Derelict/damaged gate onto pitches from BMX track, restored if needed or removed and fence restored.
- c) Successful re-turfing of goal area at Pitch 1, (playground end). End of season review and other pitch areas.
- 4. Youth and Community Building
- a) Used by Scouts during term time evenings, Yoga on Tuesday mornings and occasional band practice. Some children parties have booked and following a visit have declined due to condition. Deep clean of carpet and kitchen floor was suggested. Probation Service currently painting walls/woodwork.
- 5. Pavilion
- a) Availability for Council meetings on Mondays?
- b) Parking. With the rough/loose stone area tarmacked and the whole area marked out formally with car parking spaces, optimum parking area could be created.
- c) Former plans for the side extension to the Pavilion, should this be reviewed?
