- 1. Reference: 20/00827/FUL: Address: **53 Fairview Drive**, **Bayston Hill**: Erection of first floor side extension and associated alterations It was **resolved unanimously to support this application**.
- 2. Reference: 20/00682/FUL: Address: **62 Lansdowne Crescent, Bayston Hill:** Erection of single storey extension and rebuilding of front garage wall It was **resolved unanimously to support this application.**
- 3. Reference: 20/00440/ADV: Address: **Bayston Hill Service Area**, Hereford Road, Bayston Hill: Erect and display 1 internally illuminated, 9-meter-high totem sign. It was noted that there were no objections from the Highway authority and **resolved unanimously to make no objection** to this application
- 4. 20/00314/ADV: **Bayston Hill Service Area**, **Hereford Road**, **Bayston Hill:** Consent to display ten various illuminated and non-illuminated signs: The

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Committee **resolved to submit a neutral comment** confirming they would not object to like for like replacement signage but observing that the service area is already very brightly lit, which has a detrimental impact on the amenity of overlooking properties and any increased illumination would tend to increase light pollution.

- 6. 20/00736/FUL: Proposed dwellings south of The Fold, Lythwood Road, Bayston Hill, Shrewsbury Erection of a pair of semi-detached bungalows: The Committee resolved to support the proposal with the following recommendation: that the status of social housing be clarified and if designated as affordable housing to make a recommendation that the bungalows be made available for first refusal for existing residents of Bayston Hill.
