

A47.17 Specification for Maintenance of Parrs Pool and Surrounding woodlands area

Area 1 Parrs Pool Once per year

- a) Remove duck weed from the pool surface annually in the spring of each year

Area 1 Parrs Pool Twice yearly

- a. To check Parrs Pool, to ensure all material including wood, willow branches and metal are removed from the pool Area. To check the inlets and outfall are clear of debris and water is allowed to flow freely.
- b. To check that aquatic plants, are in good condition; split any clumps and fill any gaps as required. Check baskets are properly anchored to the floor of the pool and repair as necessary.
- c. To keep all edges around the Parrs Pool free of weeds and overgrown branches of trees especially areas where benches and tables may be located. (The relevant area to be defined by the perimeter path around the pool)
- d. To ensure all hard surface walkways are free of branches and stones by the use of sweeping or blowing of the paths
- e. In General ensure that Parrs Pool are fit for use by Residents, Visitors, and the Disabled. If any problems contact the Parish Clerk Tel 01743 87651

Area 2 Surrounding Areas Twice Yearly

- f. Keep all weeds at a reasonable height especially near Brookfield entrance and in alongside the marked walkways
- g. Sweep or blow the remainder of the hard surface areas
- h. Remove fallen branches
- i. Cut the grass at the Brookfield's Entrance
- j. In General, ensure that all surrounding areas are fit for use by Residents, Visitors, and the Disabled. If any problems contact the Parish Clerk Tel 01743-
