Covid 19: Closure of library.

15 May 2020

A phased re-opening of libraries will take place when it is safe to do so. This will likely to include only the largest branches initially , with smaller branches to follow afterwards. All appropriate social distancing measures will be put in place to ensure the safety of staff and customers. A phased approach to re-opening means that initially only certain services and functions will be available. Currently we can't set-out a timescale for the re-opening of libraries. Decisions will be based on the changing lockdown circumstances and the detail of what services and business are allowed to open, on specific guidance from national library agencies, and on relevant advice from Public Health England. In the meantime our online services remain available and continue to be developed so that our customers can still use and support their library services.

Rest assured that as a service we're keen to open our doors as soon as we can but we do have particular challenges to overcome particularly with regard to our spaces and the lending of books.
