## **Clerks Report November 2023**

The Repair Café held a successful recruitment morning and held their first session on Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> November. Over a dozen items were brought along for repair and more than half were able to be fixed there and then! Donations were generous and the money can them be used to purchase supplies.

On Friday 10<sup>th</sup> we held our 2<sup>nd</sup> Remembrance Observance. It attracted approx. 30 residents. We had a range of speakers including pupils from Oakmeadow, the RBL and members of the clergy. Next years date of Monday 11<sup>th</sup> November has been pencilled in.

Peter and I attended 2 useful exhibitions that happened on the same day at the NEC. The Highways exhibition – we met several providers of SIDs and also providers of street furniture. The 2<sup>nd</sup> was Solar and Storage which was fascinating, we made contact with some UK based companies (although all the kit in the very large hall is made in China). We will be having a meeting this week with a provider to discuss battery storage from our solar panels and maybe even upgrading what we have?

Broadband at the Pavilion – I have found out that the site does not have a registered address and therefore the broadband company won't help us. I have spoken to the Royal Mail and Shropshire Council and have the application to make it a "proper" address.

A new bench has been installed on Landsdowne Road next to the bus stop.
