The defibrillators have been serviced, the machine at the Memorial Hall that we recently adopted is defunct, I will bring this as an item to the next meeting for discussion. It is not registered and we have put signs on it.

There are 3 large planning applications pending in and near the parish, Oaklands School site, commercial development on Otley Road and the Land off Lyth Hill development.
