## Clerks report October Full Council 2024

Staff appraisals have now been completed and details have been shared with Finance and Personnel Committee on Sept 30<sup>th</sup>.

D Engler will leave us at the end of October, recruitment to this post is later on the agenda this evening. Dave has been a great addition and has worked flexibly and proactively for which we are grateful.

The Community Energy Fund application was successful and we have been awarded £39k in order to make our Pavilion project as environmentally friendly as possible. I have already started discussions with our successful contractor RenewEv who will shortly be meeting with us and providing a project plan. The planning application for the project is now live and should conclude on 21st November.

The telegraph poles installed without permission are being removed shortly.

We have begun discussions with the new agent for Balfours -as their previous long serving agent had left-regarding the Glebe. A meeting is being planned; we have agreement for this in principle but no details as yet.

The Macmillan coffee afternoon raised £168, with thanks to the Memorial Hall for hosting.

The apple pressing event was a success once again, thank you to several Cllrs and Peter for attending.

Redrow have requested a meeting so I have added an additional Full Council meeting on November 4<sup>th</sup>, normal time 7.15 but it will be at Christ Church – agenda to follow this week.
