

Re: Tree work at Public space in Bayston Hill, SY3 0LW (what3words location: boil.dishes.shared)

Thank you very much for asking us to quote requesting a quote for the tree work required based on the e-mail we received from Zoe Adlington on 10th January 2025, which we have now visited.

We are pleased to quote as follows

Work as per Zoe's recommendations

x2 tree groups comprising Willow, Birch and Sycamore

Approximately 36 stems in total including fallen stems

Fell all to ground level

To include clearance of fallen top from storm damaged Poplar (tree to remain)

Remove timber from site

Chip brash and remove, or spread in woodland areas where appropriate

Provide warning signs and banksmen for footpaths in area

Provide Tractor and Forwarder

Provide Timber Lorry and Crane

£3850.00 + VAT

Access is via the wooden gate into the work area, adjacent to 42 Brookfield, SY3 0LR. Permission to prune these trees to gain access has been agreed with the home owner (Mr John Parry - 07852 590 831).









A key will be required for the lock on the gate.

The ground is currently very wet and drier ground conditions will be required to prevent excessive ground damage. The trees are however likely to host nesting birds and ideally would be completed prior to bird nesting season. It may be that work should be completed before nesting season and in which case some damage to the ground may occur. This situation can be assessed at the proposed time of work and we would be happy to discuss further.
