# **Report 1** Adoption of revised Planning Policy

#### 17/03844/FUL - 3 Berwyn Drive

**Erection of two storey side extension, rear single storey extension and alterations to existing dwelling,** (see plans attached). There have been no comments or objections recorded against this application and it does not conflict with current or draft policies, it is therefore recommended it be supported.

#### 17/03983/HHE - Bomere Farm, Sharpstones Lane

Erection of a single storey rear extension with lean to roof to a detached dwelling, dimensions 6.010 metres beyond rear wall, 3.750 metres maximum height, 2.500 metres high to eaves.
