F38.23/24 DRAFT BUDGET

The Committee looked at the draft budget line by line. The majority of items had been increased by 5%. Some items had remained the same as there was not an expected increase in these items. The council tax base figures have not been received yet so precept was estimated on last years

figures equalling a precept increase of 3.3% on this first draft.

The reserve amounts had no change this year shown so far. The income amount looked inflated due to payments for some large invoices paid in this current year and not 2023/24.

The financial position to date was shown with big items (zipwire, allotment fencing, pitch maintenance) – these items will be paid for from the earmarked reserves and CIL monies and have not been vired, this is to show variance. Committee asked if this could be produced without showing these items so members could see both. Draft budget will now be received at Full Council on December 16<sup>th</sup>.
