Sensory Garden Report 15.2.2021.

The BHPC Sensory Garden looked in good order and was being enjoyed by walkers and young families. It appeared that regular maintenance work had been carried out.

<u>Fences</u>

Fences were in good repair.

<u>Map</u>

Faded and broken, lectern style display is fine but the map needs replacing.

<u>The Orchard</u>

The fruit trees had been pruned and looked a much better shape than when previously seen, bark around the base of the trees and the grass recently mowed. Trees need labelling



<u>Paths</u>

There was a clear pathway through the site which varied in surface.

Around two of the sensory beds there was a good cover of gravel in different textures.

Most of the paths had embedded gravel which prevented the path from being muddy. In a few places a thin layer of bark had been placed on the path, again preventing a slippery surface. In some places the path was very muddy and slippery.

Pond

The pond was full and brimming over its original size. The wooden walkway and jetty was in very good order with the exception of a few very small areas of chicken wire that covers the wooden surface which was in need of repair.

Recycling Bins

Sited next to the bin by the entrance.



Seating

The seat in memory of a resident, directly in front of the sound bed, is rotting and therefore needs replacing but still retaining the resident's plaque.

A few more log benches



and picnic tables needed.



Sensory Beds

The Sound Bed is mostly made up of a wall of bamboo but little else in the way of natural sound. Mulch needed to prevent weeds. In the Sound Bed are several 'Bug Hotels' made by local children which are admirable and to be greatly valued. It may be that the 'Bug Hotels' should have an area dedicated to them or they are re-positioned around the sensory garden so that they are more evenly spaced to provide a home for bugs around the site.

The Touch Bed has a few plants that have different textures. These plants need to be checked for risk of allergies etc if people are being encouraged to touch. It maybe that specialist advice is sought and/or a warning sign placed in the bed. The edge is damaged and rotten. Mulch needed to prevent weeds.

The Taste Bed needs restocking and mulch to prevent weeds. The edge is damaged and rotten. Labels needed.



There is another Bed where it is unclear what it is. In this Bed is a very large Flax with very sharp leaves with spikes on. It could be used as the Sight Bed but would need re planting in some places. Edge damaged and rotten. Mulch needed to prevent weeds.

There is not a Smell Bed so one would need creating and planting with suitable plants topsoil and mulch.

<u>Signage</u>

None around the site. Signposts needed to direct to sites and signs by individual sites. Identification labels for trees and Danger - warning sign by the pond. (lifebelt ???)

Trees

The majority of trees looked in good order but many off shoots are appearing which are filling the spaces between the original trees. In the future this could prevent the original trees from thriving. Some specimen trees need labels for identification. In the future larger trees will needed pruning and some areas may need thinning out. Specialist advice may be required.



Wildlife

Re-site 'Bug Hotels' and hang bird boxes. Children's activity to build more bird boxes.
